Wood is lightweight but very strong, once it has been treated. Besides, it lasts for ages: the oldest wooden building was built in the 8th century.


ADVANTAGE WOOD

India's ancient architectural science, Vastushastra, is based on the play of the five basic elements of the universe: Akash (Sky), Prithvi (Earth), Jal (Water), Agni (Fire) and Vayu (Wind). The science aims at harnessing the positive energy of the elements for a wholesome life. Kerala's architecture is heavily influenced by Vastushastra and the state's architectural wonders stand tall in testimony of the skill of the Viswakarma sthapatihis who worked to Vastu principles.

Kerala has indigenously developed Thachushastra (Science of Carpentry); this science owes its origin to the unique geography and conditions of the state which has easy accessibility to timber and uses it heavily.

Thachushastra emphasizes on timber being derived from a living form, i.e. wood; when it is used for construction, it has its own life which must be synthesised in harmony with its surroundings and the people who dwell in the structure. Wood also features prominently in the ancient science of Feng Shui, as one of the basic five elements along with fire, water, metal and earth. According to this Chinese science, wood represents creativity and growth. Feng Shui advocates that it be used in tandem with metal for optimum energy in the home.

At Woodhaven, our craftsmen with a strong lineage of the master craftsmen of Kerala create houses which integrate ancient values from different Eastern philosophies in design and implementation.

MOISTURE CONTROL

Wood is hygroscopic; wood can take on & shed large amounts of water in order to balance itself with the environment, without harming its innate qualities.



ADVANTAGE WOOD

Woodhaven believes in enhancing the architectural traditions of the East with the research-backed technology prowess of the West. We use the framing technique to ensure a uniform, consistent and strong structure; this involves the fitting together of pieces to give support and shape to a structure.

We also use the tongue and groove joint to ensure that flat panels can be joined strongly together to form a uniform flat surface. This kind of strong joint is commonly used in wood flooring, panelling and parquetry. Framing construction helps in reducing the construction time to a large extent. So, a typical single bed cottage of 400 sq ft will take only 2-4 weeks to assemble. The advancement in production techniques has given rise to new methods of construction.

New-age wood materials are crack-free and homogeneous so that they retain their original shape and size over the years. Besides, new fire-proofing treatments, termite treatment techniques and weather-proofing treatments enable us to create sturdy houses that can withstand conditions of high wind, heavy rain and even earthquakes.

Using advanced wooden products means we can create multifunctional assemblies of any scale within a short span, at reasonable cost. Wood, being a flexible material, allows us to do customised structural and decorative designs.
